- Judges will pick 1st & 2nd Place in all categories. A people's choice award (made by the public) will also be given. Judging will be based on aroma, appearance, consistency, and taste.
- Teams have a 4 member limit. Each team will receive 4 tasting armbands.

Event Entry Information

This purpose of this event is to raise funds for TASC. TASC helps to supplement the Athletic Department's budget and aids in the purchase of uniforms, equipment and other items necessary to keep our athletes healthy and safe. TASC's mission is to support and promote Rebel Athletics by uniting students, parents, coaches, faculty, staff in a way that enhances school spirit, providing moral and financial support.

Registration & Entry Fee Information:

\$75 per team if turned in before January 22, 2016. Late registration fee will be \$125 per entry after January 22, 2016.

GUMBO COOK-OFF RULES

- 1. At least one person per team must attend the pre-cooking meeting on Tuesday, January 26th @ 5:30 in Room 2.
- 2. Must register and pay entry fee by 3:00 on January 22, 2016. Any team registering after that time will be considered a Late Entry and will have to pay \$125 to enter the competition.
- 3. Single pots only. Judging and public will eat the same gumbo. Minimum pot size is 10 gallons (40 quarts).
- 4. Water and electricity will NOT be provided or be accessible.
- 5. There will be three categories: Seafood, non-seafood & wild game. Non-seafood competition is limited to any combination of chicken, turkey, pork or beef. Wild game is any wild game meat. All meat must be boneless. Seafood must be clearly marked as seafood.
- 6. Rice must be included for serving purposes but will not be considered in judging. Rice can be pre-cooked.
- 7. Jar/Dry roux is permitted.
- 8. All gumbo cooking is to take place at TCH. Exceptions are rice & smoked meat/sausage.
- 9. Meat can be seasoned ahead of time.
- 10. Judging will begin at 11:30. Gumbo must be ready for pickup @ 11:15. A TASC rep will pick up gumbo entries and bring to judges. **DO NOT BRING YOUR ENTRY TO THE JUDGES. THIS WILL BE GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION**.
- 11.TASC will provide judging bowls and spoons.
- 12. Public tasting will begin at 11:30. Each booth must provide small tasting containers and spoons.
- 13. Cooking teams must provide their own cooking & cleaning supplies, serving utensils, tents, tables, chairs. All items must be removed by 6:00 PM on Saturday.
- 14. Water, soft drinks, and limited concessions will be available for purchase.
- 15. No glass bottles.
- 16. Team max is 4 members. Each team will receive 4 tasting armbands. Additional armbands will be sold for \$5.00 per person.
- 17. No dumping of food, liquid, grease or trash is allowed on cooking site. TCH has a dumpster at the gym entrance.
- 18. No vehicles will be permitted in the cooking areas once it is open to the public.
